

## Adjudication Criteria – Global Growth Programme 2023

The entries will be scored according to the following criteria:

|   | <b>Criteria</b>   |

| 1 | Administrative and technical compliance   |
| 2 | The expenses incurred (the higher the expenses claimed the lower the score)   |
| 3 | The clarity of the plan in relation to the company's declared goals and strategy.   |
| 4 | The chances of success in achieving the desired results in view of the overall scenario (internal as well as external factors).                     |
| 5 | The potential benefits to the Maltese economy in terms of value-added activities and job creation, as a result of the company achieving its' goals. |
| 6 | The company's knowledge of the target markets and potential clients.  |
| 7 | The company's HR capacity to execute the plan, follow up on leads as well as its administrative capacity to claim in a timely and orderly manner.   |

The criteria are equally weighted and scored on a scale of 1-10. Criterium 1 is scored by deducting points for missing or incorrect information. Criterium 2 is scored by relative scoring. The remaining criteria are initially scored independently by 3 adjudicators, who subsequently agree on consolidated scores.
