He has lectured in Malta and several countries abroad, published numerous historical articles and has been the Chairman of both the Heritage Advisory Committee and the Valletta Rehabilitation Committee. Konrad is also the chief editor behind AP's publications *A Printed Thing* and *Founding Myths of Architecture*. He is a member of the Boards of Experts of the European Urban Space Prize.

He was Chairman of the Valletta 2018 Foundation from 2009-2013, during which period the Foundation delivered Valletta's successful bid for the title for European Capital of Culture for 2018. He

was also a board member of Heritage Malta, a member of the Creative Economy Consultative Body and was appointed to the Malta Arbitration Centre's Panel of Arbitrators. He is currently an EFFE (Europe for Festivals, Festivals for Europe) Expert.
